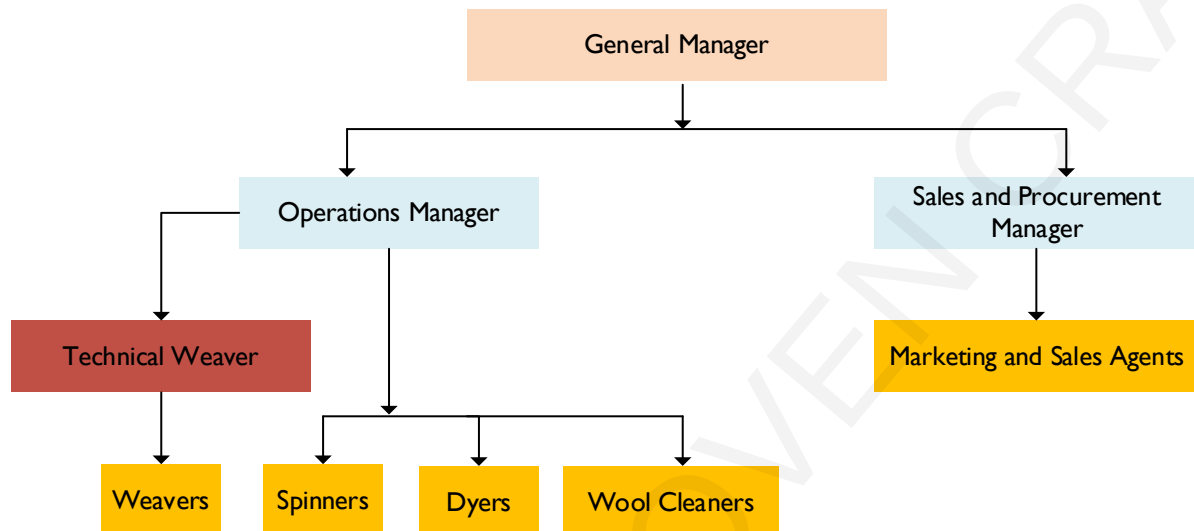

Our experience spans over eight (8) years and ranges on several products highlighted below.

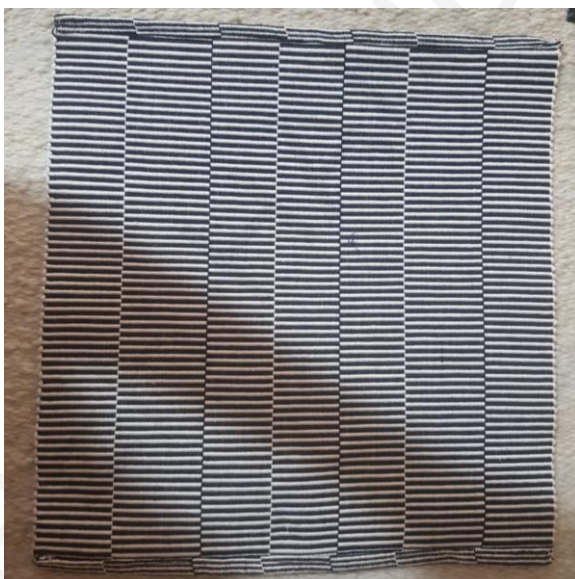
4.1 Handwoven Carpets

Handmade pieces that bring comfort, style, and texture to any interior.



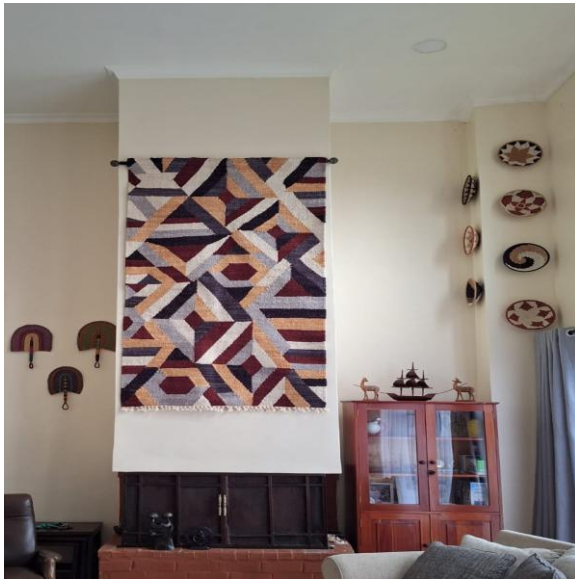
